

ORDINANCE 2019-08

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 3-104 AND 12-110 OF THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF OZAWKIE, KANSAS TO TEMPORARILY ALLOW CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AND/OR CERAL MALT BEVERAGES ON CITY OWNED PUBLIC PROPERTY IF APPROVED THROUGH A RESOLUTION PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL AND AMENDING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF OZAWKIE, KANSAS:

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to have the ability to occasionally grant the right for the citizens of Ozawkie to consume alcoholic beverages and/or cereal malt beverages upon specifically described public property, in instances such as a fall festival, during a limited time period and subject to certain conditions; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to amend those certain sections to provide the opportunity for the City Council to temporarily allow the consumption of alcoholic beverages and/or cereal malt beverages following the passage of a resolution.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF OZAWKIE, KANSAS THAT:

SECTION 1. Code Section 3-104 of the City Code of the City of Ozawkie, Kansas is hereby amended to read as follows:

3-104 CONSUMPTION ON PUBLIC PROPERTY. No person shall drink or consume any alcoholic liquor or cereal malt beverage on city owned property unless temporarily permitted by the passage of a Resolution approved by the City Council. (K.S.A. Supp 41-719; Ord. 2019-08)

SECTION 2. Code Section 12-110 of the City Code of the City of Ozawkie, Kansas is hereby amended to read as follows:

12-109 PROHIBITION AGAINST ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AND CEREAL MALT BEVERAGES. Unless temporarily permitted by the passage of a Resolution approved by the City Council, it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to use, consume or have on the premises of any park or other city property within the city any alcoholic liquor or cereal malt beverage. SECTION 3. REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be effective from and after the date of its publication in the official City newspaper as provided by law.
